

CRITERIA FOR WALL OF HONOR NOMINATION

1. No more than one person may be inducted each year into the “Wall of Honor” unless no one was chosen the year before, then two people may be inducted.
2. The nominee must be a former Clyde student, teacher, administrator or a person employed in some capacity by the Clyde School district.
3. The person must have had an impact on the school system and/or the City of Clyde or must have had an impact on society wherever he/she resides as demonstrated by service to business, education, military and/or community. The nominee must be 50 years of age or older. If the person is deceased, he/she would not be eligible for nomination until he/she would have been 50 years of age.
4. Nominations shall be made by letter to the Homecoming Association officers explaining what the person has done and why he/she should be accepted as a member of the “Wall of Honor.” Two people must sign the letter of nomination.
