New Immunization Requirements

The Texas Department of State Health Services has announced changes to the Texas elementary and secondary school immunization requirements. Beginning August 1, 2009, students entering Kindergarten and 7th grade will be required to show documentation that the following vaccines have been received.

Kindergarten students:

Varicella- two doses
(Written verification of a chickenpox illness by the parent, guardian, or doctor will waive the requirement for the vaccine)
Hepatitis A- 2 doses
MMR- Measles, Mumps, Rubella- 2 doses

7th grade students-Meningococcal vaccine- one dose Varicella vaccine- two doses (Written verification of a chickenpox illness by the parent, guardian, or doctor will waive the requirement for the vaccine) Tdap: Tetanus, Diphtheria and acellular Pertussis-one dose required only if it has been 5 years since the last tetanus-containing vaccine.
