CRITERIA FOR WALL OF HONOR NOMINATION

- 1. No more than one person may be inducted each year into the "Wall of Honor" unless no one was chosen the year before, then two people may be inducted.
- 2. The nominee must be a former Clyde student, teacher, administrator or a person employed in some capacity by the Clyde School district.
- 3. The person must have had an impact on the school system and/or the City of Clyde or must have had an impact on society wherever he/she resides as demonstrated by service to business, education, military and/or community. The nominee must be 50 years of age or older. If the person is deceased, he/she would not be eligible for nomination until he/she would have been 50 years of age.
- 4. Nominations shall be made by letter to the Homecoming Association officers explaining what the person has done and why he/she should be accepted as a member of the "Wall of Honor." Two people must sign the letter of nomination.
